

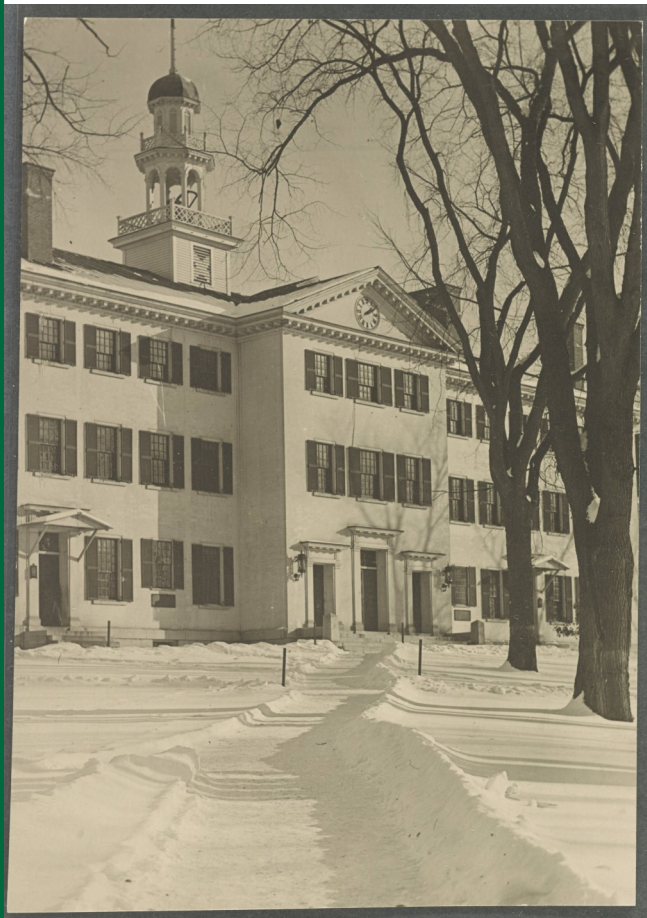
Digging Dartmouth
